



## **SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

for Academic Year 2008

**Note: This application must be typewritten, it must be completed in its entirety, and a photo of yourself must be attached. Applications must be postmarked by May 1, 2008. Results of judging by the Scholarship Committee will be mailed to all applicants no later than May 26, 2008. The scholarship award will be presented June 2, 2008 at the Al Glaze Memorial Scholarship Golf Tournament held at the Visalia Country Club in Visalia, CA. Attendance by the successful candidates is mandatory. Please be aware that monies will be provided for the Fall Term, 2008 upon proof of registration as a full time student, unless a determination to the contrary is made by the President of the GCSACC. Any incorrect, false or misleading responses will be justification for rejection of this application or the withdrawal of a scholarship, if awarded.**

**Please provide the following on as many separate sheets as necessary:**

- 1. Student's name, current address, and phone number.**
- 2. Parents' names, addresses, and phone numbers.**
- 3. Name of college or university you are currently attending or that you intend to enroll in and any other colleges, universities, trade or vocational schools you have attended in the past. You may include Internet courses that you are taking or intend to take. Be advised that your scholarship will not be paid until you have provided proof of completion of such Internet courses.**
- 4. Name and location of High School(s) attended, fields of study, awards and achievements.**
- 5. List your major and minor field of study and the total number of college credits you have completed. Indicate quarter or semester units. Indicate overall GPA.**
- 6. List all the classes you have taken related to Plant Science, Soil Science and Management Preparation. You may include courses taken over the Internet. Indicate the number of credits awarded for that class and the grade you received.**

- 7. List any other classes that you intend to take relating to Plant Science, Soil Science and Management Preparation, prior to graduation and your planned date of graduation.**
- 8. List all clubs and associations in which you are a member. Include organizations not necessarily associated with school or the turfgrass industry.**
- 9. Give a brief history of your employment background. Include the name and type of business, the location, your job title, duties, and length of service at that job.**
- 10. List any relatives or close friends you may have in the golf course industry. Indicate their relationship to you, their place of employment and job title.**
- 11. Include letters of reference from your faculty advisor. You may include letters of reference from faculty members, a golf course superintendent with whom you have worked, any other employers, association or club leaders or advisors, and associates.**
- 12. Write a statement describing yourself. Include the reasons you entered the field of turfgrass management, the reasons and needs you have in applying for this award and your plans and goals for your first years after graduation.**
